Mont Albert Primary School Policy

ENROLMENT

PURPOSE

To ensure the right of each child within the school's designated boundary area to a place in the school.

AIMS

- To maintain the student-teacher ratio so that teaching and learning are enhanced.
- To provide parents wishing to enrol their children at Mont Albert Primary School with clear enrolment guidelines.

GUIDELINES

Where there are insufficient places at a school for all students who seek entry, students are enrolled in the following priority order:

- 1. Students for whom the school is the designated neighbourhood school.
- 2. Students with a sibling at the same permanent address who are attending the school at the same time.
- 3. Where the regional director has restricted the enrolment, students who reside nearest the school.
- 4. Students seeking enrolment on specific curriculum grounds.
- 5. All other students in order of closeness of their home to the school.
- 6. In exceptional circumstances, compassionate grounds.

Administration

The enrolment policy will be administered by the Principal.
